To Whom It May Concern:

Section 104(d) of the William F. Goodling Child Nutrition Reauthorization Act of 1998 requires schools and institutions participating in the NSLP and SBP in the contiguous United States to purchase to the maximum extent practicable, domestic commodities or products for use in meals served under the program.

The legislation defines “domestic commodity or product” as one that is produced in the United States and is processed in the United States, substantially using agricultural commodities that are produced in the United States, with more than 51% of the cost of the agricultural goods being domestic.

We, Del Monte Foods, Inc., certify that the canned and Fruit Cup® products we market to schools have at least 51% US agricultural content and comply with the aforementioned provision.
